**CURRICULUM:** We will continue to explore Traditional Tales in **English**, with The Ugly Duckling and the Frog Prince.  
In **Computing**, we will be using our positivity and resilience to write our own code. These skills will also be required in the Commando Joe sessions in PE where the children are set team missions to achieve each week.  
In **Geography** lessons we will be learning about the UK and comparing it with other countries.  
In **Science** we will be learning about life cycles of animals and we're looking forward to an exciting trip to Butterfly World nr Stockton  
In **Maths** we will be starting to look at division and multiplication, measurement and money.

**GOOGLE CLASSROOM:** We will be using Google Classroom for homework.

**PHONICS SCREENING:** As some of you will be aware Year One children will take part in the national phonics screening check at the end of the year. This should not be any cause for concern as the children are well prepared for this experience.
