Blyth Market Pavilion to Blyth Tall Ship

30 minutes, mainly flat terrain and a gentle pace. Follow the heritage trail from our October Open day and discover the rich tapestry of Blyth's history. You will stroll from the bustling centre to the iconic Blyth Tall Ship Workshop at South Harbour Quayside, viewing a blend of historical landmarks and scenic views. We'll return to the Blyth Tall Ship Workshop for a cuppa and a chat.

Starting on the 30th of October

Blyth Tall Ship to LV50 & Back

Around 2 hours and 30 minutes.

Come with us to visit the LV50 Lightship at the Royal Northumberland Yacht Club.

We will go through Ridley Park into the yacht basin where we will find the historic LV50. We will have a tour of the vessel, refreshments and then we'll return to Blyth Tall Ship.

Starting on the 6th November

Blyth Tall Ship to Blyth Battery & Back

Around 3 hours.

Walk back in time to the Blyth Battery, a world war one and two Coastal Defence Museum on Blyth Beach. If the circumstances allow we will have a tour of the battery museum and some refreshments before setting off to return to the workshop
