


The EYFS Nativity had us all “awww-ing” in delight at the cuteness of their Nativity.

And KS1 had us guffaawing with laughter at Humph the huffy Camel. A brilliantly entertaining performance.



Did you know that your child is entitled to free school meals including a packed lunch if the class is out on a school trip?




