PE Kit

Topic

Maths - Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

The multiplication tables check (MTC) is statutory for all year 4 pupils in England.

The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will help schools to identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided. The online test will take place on one day between Monday 5 June and Friday 16 June 2023. Please ensure that your child is accessing the online homework that will help them to become completely fluent in their multiplication tables.

Arrival and Collection

Year 4 pupils are asked to arrive at school at 8.30am. The register will close at 8.50am. After this time, children must be taken to the school office to be registered. Collection is at 3.15pm. Please be prompt for the collection of your child as staff often have meetings to attend after school.
