# Attendance and Sickness at New Delaval Primary School

We all know that the importance of regular attendance cannot be emphasised strongly enough. It is so important for children to be in school and we know that we can rely on your support with this. Our aim is to increase the percentage attendance for the children and we will be taking on board the new guidelines which came into effect in August for monitoring and supporting families with any attendance issues.

If your child is unwell they will need time off school, e.g. if they have a high temperature or sickness and/or diarrhoea. If your child does have sickness or diarrhoea then they are required to be off school for 48 hours after the last time they were sick or had diarrhoea. This protects everyone in the school community.

Holidays in term time should be avoided wherever possible.

Please can we ask that if you need to inform us about absence that you do so by ringing the school office.

#### Punctuality at New Delaval Primary School Doors open at 8:30am and close at 8:45am

If your child arrives at school after 8:45am then they will be recorded as late. Please make sure your child is in school on time!
