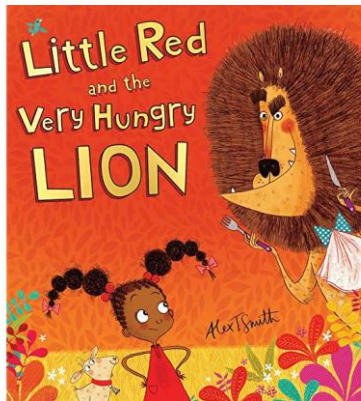
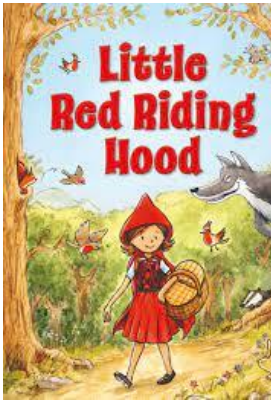

Little Red Riding Hood/Little Red and the Very Hungry Lion by Alex T Smith

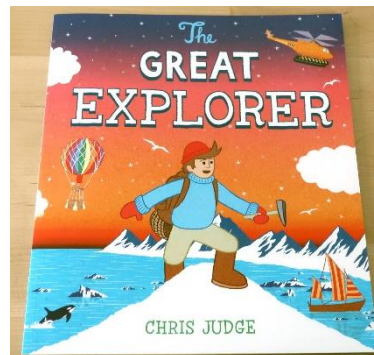
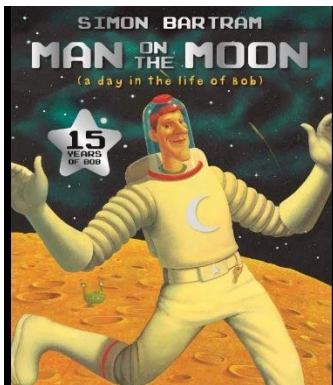


English links- Question sentences, noun phrases, sequencing, sentence punctuation.

Bob- Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram and The Great Explorer by Chris Judge

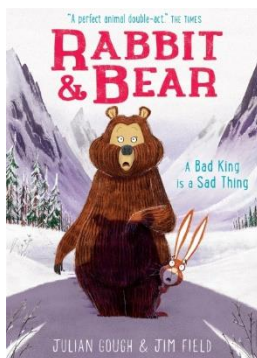


English links – Sequence words, commas in lists, sentence punctuation.

English links- Adverbs, subordination and co-ordination, exclamation sentences, adding ‘er and ‘est’, adjectives

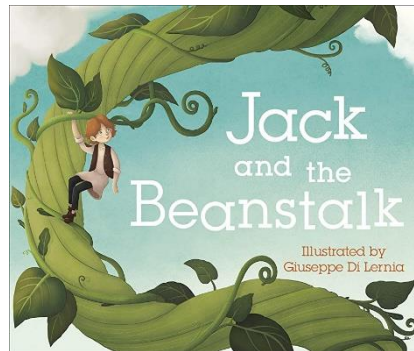
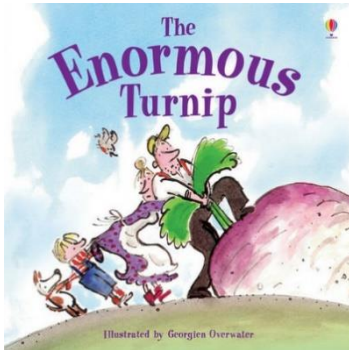
Extra links- Quality of friendships and resilience.

Recognising simple recurring literary language in stories, teamwork, good vs bad.

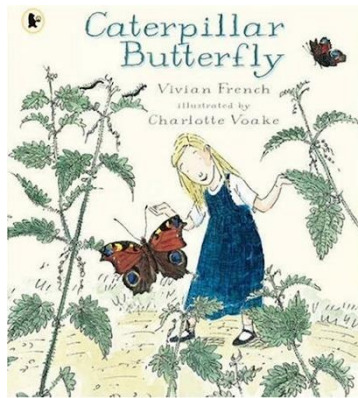
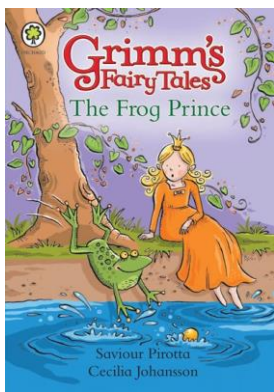
Summer 1
