Dear Parent/Carer

It was lovely to see so many parents and children at the school gates on Monday morning and I'm glad to tell you we are now 4 days in and everyone is settling in really well. I am thrilled to have a full school again!

Whilst school is open we are not yet back to normal, we are still observing all of the social distancing measures that were in place at the end of last year to keep our school environment as safe as possible for both our pupils and staff.

We have had a number of enquiries and comments from parents and neighbours around social distancing and the new traffic restrictions around school so I thought it would be useful to share a couple of reminders with you.

Face Coverings – these must be worn (unless you have a medical exemption) when dropping off and collecting children and current social distancing rules must be adhered to at all times.
