## Year 1 Class Newsletter. Summer Term 2023



Welcome to the Summer Term! I can not believe that it is the last term of the school year already — we have got lots of lovely things planned now that the weather is getting better. The children have already been enjoying playing on the field and we are watch out Tadpoles with great interest. We will be tidying up our outside area over the next few weeks too and will move our learning outdoors whenever possible. **ENGLISH** — Our main texts in English this term will be The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch and Katie Morag Delivers the Mail. We will be perfecting our phonics, spelling and handwriting skills to write sentences about the characters, setting and events in these stories and learning about what life is like on an island too.

<u>MATHS</u> — We will be covering our final units for the year this term looking at Shape Space and Measures, including money, time and fractions. In our number lessons we will focus on reasoning and problem solving with numbers up to 100 and begin to explore multiplication and division using practical methods (no need to start learning times tables yet!)

**SCIENCE** – Our Science topics will continue to explore Living Things and Habitats focussing on growing plants and how plants adapt to live in various habitats around the world. We will also become 'Super Scientists' when we learn how to carry out simple experiments using fair tests and look at how we can record and share information with others.

<u>TOPIC —</u> Our History and Geography learning supports our English texts this half term. We will learn about a famous lighthouse in our local area - 2 actually !), a famous woman from the past who used all of our school RESPECT characteristics to help others in a daring rescue off the Farne Islands here in Northumberland. We will learn about seaside holidays in the past and explore features of the coast. We even plan to design and make our own island to live on !

 $\overline{\textit{TRIP}}-$  Our end of year trip will celebrate all of this term's learning - I wonder if you can guess where it might be ? Look out for more information next  $\frac{1}{2}$  term!
