which was donated to the Royal British Legion to support soldiers and their families.





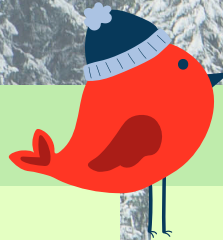
Introducing the Digital Leaders
