
We have two topics this term. In geography we will look at 'Violent Volcanoes', and explore how they're made and how they change the landscape.

Literacy

We'll be reading a range of class texts including 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit and 'Tales of the Greek Heroes' by Roger Lancelyn Green to support the writing of different genres including a recount of events, creative writing and poetry.
