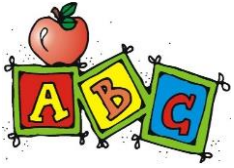


Year One News

Spring Term Topics

Whether learning at home or at school this term learning will focus on a number of common topics.

In History we will be learning about two great fires; The Great Fire of London and The Great Fire of Gateshead and Newcastle. We will think about what life was like at the time and the causes and effects of these terrible events.

After half term we have a Geography topic and will be Going on Safari ! Learning about a different environment and what life is like in a hot country for the people, plants and animals living there.

In Science we will be considering the growth and survival of animals, including humans. We will look at the sequence of growth and the basic needs for survival. We will then go on to learn about different habitats and how they support the growth and survival of those living in them.

Ms Newell has two design technology projects for you where you will research, design, plan and make a bridge and a puppet to support our topics.

In Computing will be learning how to use the Internet safely to research our topics and how to use simple spreadsheets and data bases to handle information.

Please log in to School360 daily and click on the 'Classroom' tab on the pupil home page. This will enable you to access the daily learning on Google Classroom.
