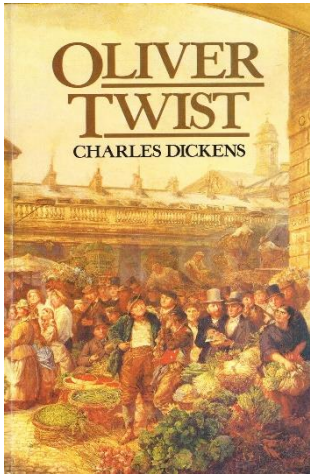


## Cycle A texts Year 3 and Year 4

Oliver Twist by Charles Dickens

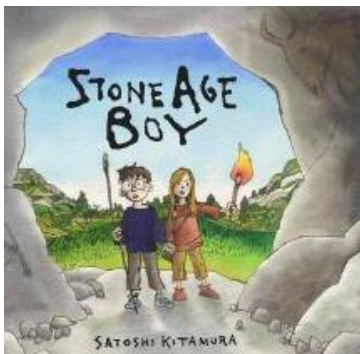


English links- Archaic language, role play, direct speech.

Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura

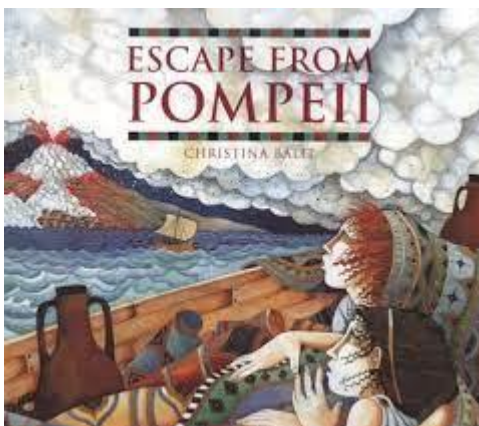


English links- Inference skills, discussion writing, and instructional writing.

Wider links- science links, history links.

### Spring 1

Escape from Pompeii by Christina Balit.

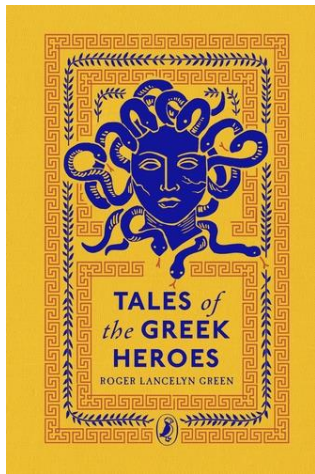


English links- Eye witness account (recount skills), narrative structure, tenses.

Wider skills- geography and history links, empathy for tragic event.

### Spring 2

English links- historical vocabulary, features/structure of a myth, drama

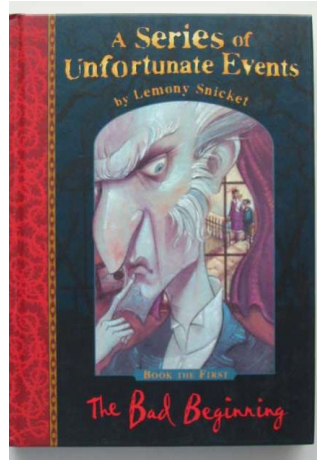
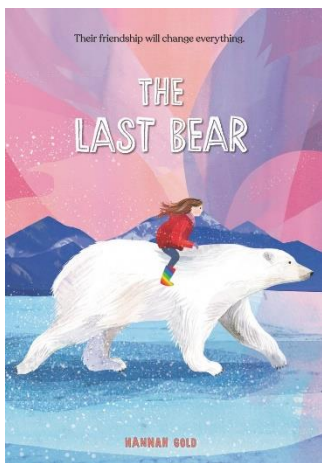


Wider links- historical links, belief from other cultures

English links- emotive language (persuasive skills), character studies, inferences to interpret feelings.

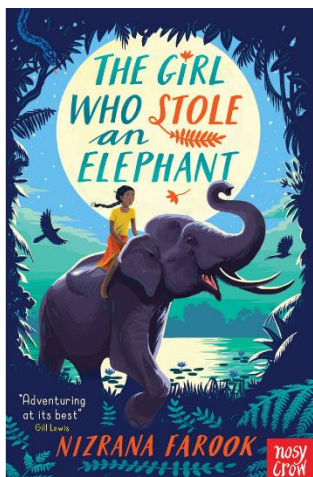


Wider links- climate change, PSHE- relationships and families,
