- Reading books will be changed each Thurs/Fri. Please keep them until the following week so that you can have lots of time to read together at home.

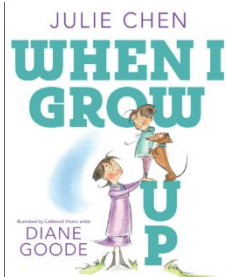
