PE Kit

Maths – Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check The multiplication tables check (MTC) is statutory for all year 4 pupils in England.

The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will help schools to identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided. The online test will take place on one day between **Monday 3rd June and Friday I 4th June 2024**. Please ensure that your child is accessing the online homework that will help them to become completely fluent in their multiplication tables.
