Year 6 Coding Workshop on Wind Turbines

On Friday 23rd January, Year 6 have been invited to attend a 'coding workshop on wind turbines' held at the Port of Blyth Energy Central Learning Hub. The workshop will be delivered by a member of their team, who is an experienced science teacher who now runs STEM workshops. The session will take place from 10am – 2pm and the pupils will be home for a usual school finish (3:15pm).

We will be getting a public transport Arriva bus to and from the event due to the distance from school. To ensure we have sufficient time to get to the bus stop, **please can pupils arrive at school on time.**

The aim of the trip is to broaden their coding skills ready for Year 7 and provide them with real life examples of when coding is used within STEM careers.
