It is with a great deal of sadness and disappointment that I have to tell you that recently our school has been the target of some mindless vandalism. During the Coronation weekend, our school building was targeted with piles of mud, rocks, stones and large bricks that had been thrown at the windows and doors of the EYFS side of school from the Pavilion. On the Tuesday morning, our Caretaker also collected over 35 golf balls from the field. These had been hit at the school from the small hill on the other side of the large hedge bordering the Golf Course and did cause some damage to windows and doors. The worst part is that some of our own children were involved. Instances like this are becoming more frequent and for children who see this damage upon their return to school it can be quite unsettling. We pride ourselves on providing a safe space and a well looked after school. We will continue to work together with families and local services to try and reduce some of the anti-social behaviour that is having a negative impact on our local community.
