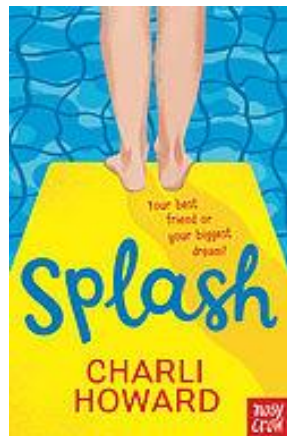
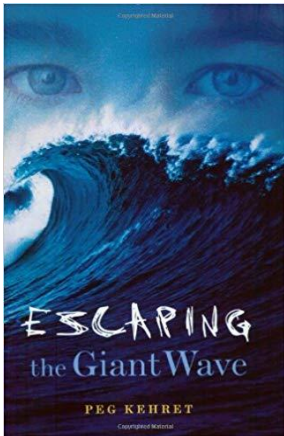


YEAR 6 SUMMER NEWSLETTER 2021
