Following a successful application for grant funding from the Blyth Celebrates Fund Cabinet of Curiosity Studio will be holding workshops for children in the new Market Pavilion building this Autumn to create paper architecture models and theatrical tunnel books showing seaside views. A series of paper architecture models will also be displayed in Blyth Library alongside free creative resources to take away.

“Seaside Souvenir” is a participatory art project exploring Blyth's architecture through paper crafts. Designed for children aged 8 to 11 and families, it includes in-person and online activities to create keepsake souvenirs of their visit. The project will feature downloadable resources, workshops in the new Market Pavilion venue and a limited edition souvenir postcard.
